

## Safety and Instructions

- A safe ride is a relaxing and fun ride!
- Safety is the number one thing we focus on and how we are able to ride for many, many years.
- No matter how safe you are, there is always a chance something can go wrong, so procedures/instructions go hand in hand with safety.
- The motorcycle operator will give instructions to the passenger to keep both the operator and the passenger safe.
- Blatant disregard to follow instructions will be grounds for ending the ride early.

### Safety and Procedures:

- 1) Riding Gear (protection)
  - 1) Helmet
  - 2) Eye protection
  - 3) Closed toe shoes (boots preferred)
  - 4) Jeans or long pants (chaps or Kevlar pants preferred)
  - 5) Long sleeve shirt or jacket (leather or Kevlar coat preferred)
- 2) Mounting the motorcycle
  - 1) First – make sure the operator is ready before you mount the motorcycle
  - 2) Mount from the left side
    - 1) Place left foot on the passenger foot peg and swing right leg over the seat
    - 2) Place right foot on the passenger foot peg
    - 3) Sit back to the backrest, get comfortable and relax
    - 4) Hold on to motorcycle or operator
- 3) Riding the motorcycle
  - 1) Hold on to motorcycle or operator for duration of the ride
  - 2) Passenger may use hand signals to assist operator if they are comfortable doing so.
  - 3) Avoid sudden/jerking movements from side to side.
  - 4) Keep feet on foot pegs at all times and point toes outward when coming to a stop.
  - 5) Do not put feet on the ground at any time
  - 6) Lean with the operator on turns and curves staying in line with operator
  - 7) Tap operator on the shoulder if you need to tell them something
  - 8) Relax and enjoy the ride
- 4) Dismounting the motorcycle
  - 1) Make sure operator is ready for you to dismount.
  - 2) Left foot on passenger foot peg
  - 3) Swing right leg over the back seat
  - 4) Do not step on or touch the exhaust pipe! HOT!
- 5) Height and Weight
  - 1) Passenger must be tall enough to reach the passenger pegs comfortably
  - 2) For the operator's comfort and safety:
    - 1) Passenger Max Weight should not exceed 200 lbs.
    - 2) Passenger Max Height should not exceed 6 ft tall
- 6) Helmets and Goggles will be provided if passenger needs them
- 7) Bandanna or head cover is recommended for sweat and shared helmets
